Svencele






Suspension Bridge in Lankupiai village
Cross the longest suspension pedestrian bridge in Lithuania across the Minija River, which connects Klaipeda and Silute districts. This metalplanked bridge is 130 m long and 1.4 m wide and is included in the Lithu anian Guinness Book of Records. There is evidence that this bridge was built in the beginning of the 20th century.

Kalniškė vlg. Kalniškė Hillfort

Across from the town of Gargzdai, the Hillfort, that is on the other side of the Minija River's valley, refers to the beginning of the history of the town of Gargzdai, when the Curonian castle Gargzdai was mentioned for the first time in 1253. The cascade of embankments and ditches, fortifications and steep scarps show that the castle was guite strong here. The renewed Kalniškė Hillfort is now a very attractive tourist place in Klaipeda district.



The Dutchman's Cap hill and ecological educational trail "Litorina"

Immerse yourself in an oasis of forest and water by visiting the Dutchman's Cap hill, which is constantly being demolished by the pounding waves and descends to the seashore at a height of 20 to 22 meters' scarp. It is assumed that the hill has been named "Dutchman's Cap"

viewed from the sea. You can see the sea view with steep shores and stony beaches from the scarp. You can find the ecological educational trail "Litorina" which is in the reserve of Dutchman's Cap landscape. It is marked with special signs and information stands, viewpoints with arbours are installed.


Jonas Gizas Ethnographic Homestead

Get familiar with the life history of Jonas Gizas (1867-1940), a Curonian La goon shipbuilder and person, who was making fishermen famous. An eth nographic homestead has a museum with a historical exposition of Drever na boatman and fisherman J.Gizas, sea-coast cultural goods, fishing and boatmaking traditions. Various educational activities are carried out.

Babylon gardens


The miniatures of the world's most famous architectural structures have been established in the well-kept area of 4 hectares, called - "Babylon gardens", which has no analogues in Lithuania. Here you will find 22 miniature architectural objects from five continents of the world: Africa, Asia, Europe, Australia and North America. You will definitely recognize the famous Sydney Opera House, the Statue of Liberty, the romantic Trevi Fountain, London Bridge, Berlin's Brandenburg Gate, the famous Atomium or the Arc de Triomphe. While walking or sitting on a bench, you can not only admire the miniatures. waterfalls and fountains of the park, listen to the music characteristic of each region of the world, but also admire over 40 000 wonderful plants of the garden. Such an abundance of vegetation gives "Babylon gardens" the status of the biggest flower park in Lithuania!





Dinosaur Park, Upside Down House

Surrounded by beautiful nature, Dinosaur Park is only 7 km away from Klaipeda, in the territory of Radailiai Manor. In this Dinosaur Park you can witness dinosaurs, who went extinct 65 million years ago. The park, which is situated in a picturesque area surrounded by nature, is a "home" to more than 40 life-size, sizzling, water-spitting and roaring dinosaurs. Here you will also find an extreme 5D cinema, labyrinth of mirrors, energetic Dino laby rinth, water balls, electric cars, carousels and more. And if you want to expe rience life upside down, visit the Upside Down House, where daily routine is playfully messed up and you can experience the unforgettable impressions and sensations!

Health trails

Seaside Regional Park, Karkle

Spend more time in the open air, clear your thoughts and strengthen your health by walking The health trail system, which consists of three circular paths: the red one - "Karkle" (4 km), the yellow one - "Dutchman's Cap" (3.5 km) and the blue one - "Kalote" (4.5 km). The total length of the health trails is 12 km. You can start hiking the health trails anywhere you like. All three health trails are circular, so after your hike you will return to where you started. You can choose one of the trails or walk all 12 km length distance, where separate trail is marked with appropriate colors. If you start hiking the health trails from the Seaside Regional Park area, you will find signboards with information about the distance you walked and this will give you a fuller picture of the calorie value of the popular food you eat.

Dreverna Small Ship Harbor and Observation Tower

Dreverna Small Ship Harbor is situated on the bank of Curonian Lagoon. The harbor offers water activities, rental of ships, boats, stand-up paddle boards and pedal boats, there are camping facilities, heated outdoor pool, tennis courts, beach-volleyball and basketball courts, children's playgrounds. There is also a restaurant in the harbor, where you can taste fish dishes of culinary heritage. One of the most attractive sights of the harbor is the 15-meterhigh observation tower, which invites you to admire the views of Nagliai Nature Reserve and the Curonian Lagoon. What is more, in summer, the regular direct trip Dreverna-Juodkrante-Dreverna is carried out, which con nects the shores of the Curonian Lagoon.
