

Neoclassicism style chapel-mausoleum of the Crucified Jesus. It has been built by Ronne squires in the churchyard of the Catholic Church on the first half of 19th century

Postmodernism style Gargždai parish Church of St. Archangel Michael built in 1990 (architect V. Lučinskas)

Gargždai Town Park has been already mentioned in 15th century and nurtured by Ronne squires in 19th century. Small-leaved limes and Norway maples remained from the old greenery. The park is equipped with functional path system and viewpoints offering the great views to river Minija and its beautiful surroundings



Gargždai town old cemetery is located in the northern part of the town. The gate arch was built in 1850s



Municipality square is the place, which attracts and delights the whole town. Square was reconstructed in 2003 by celebrating 750th anniversary of the town name. The square is surrounded by the buildings of Klaipėda district municipality administration and Gargždai town children's music school; the Church of St. Archangel Michael is seen at the distance




Modern cinema "Minija" with the selected exposition of photo and film equipment has been opened in 2015
